offers 24/7/365 shelter  
service:

- ♦ **men - 40 cots**
- ♦ **women - 12 cots**
- ♦ **families - 2 suites**

- There is a nominal fee charged per night for cots.
- Wake-up call is 7am for 8:30am checkout.
- Check-in is 5:00 pm to 11:00 pm Sun through Thurs.
- Check-ins on Fri and Sat close at midnight.

*(Other curfew rules apply to clients staying more than 1 night).*

## General Rules:

1. No one will be admitted who appears to have been drinking or using drugs.
2. Smoking is prohibited in the building, and there is a designated "smoke shack" on the premise.
3. Food is allowed in designated areas only.
4. Client belongings must be stored neatly under bed or in locker and personal cot area must be kept clean.
5. Clients are required to keep themselves neat and clean; showers are available from 5am-11am daily.
6. All clients will be dressed appropriately at all times - revealing clothing is not allowed.
7. Sleepwear is required due to nightly bed checks in the building.
8. Any clients acting in an inappropriate and/or sexual manner with another client will be given a 24hr suspension.
9. Clients are responsible for their own belongings. Anything left on check-out will be held for 1 week only before being disposed .
10. Rotary House of the Wapiti Community Dorm Society assumes NO responsibility for any injuries sustained on the premise, or for loss or damage of any personal belongings
11. Vehicles must be registered at the office, and parked in the North parking lot.
12. Everyone is expected to do 1 hour of volunteer work daily.
13. **STRICTLY PROHIBITED:** weapons, drugs, drug paraphernalia, and alcohol in or on the surrounding premise (including vehicles).
14. Visitors and pets are also prohibited.
15. **ABUSIVE LANGUAGE AND/OR BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.** Please respect staff and other residents.

*Occupancy allowed only on signed agreement to the above rules and to allow random checks, searches of personal effects & belongings at the discretion of staff. You will be asked to leave. If any banned items are found, and it is at the manager's discretion if/when you will be allowed to return.*
